

125th Thank you >>>



Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Amen.

We are finally here - safe and sound in Buffalo Center. Who knew then, that after I accepted the call to be the pastor at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, on June 13, that so much would change in mine and my family's lives, along with many challenges: me falling and breaking my face, my subsequent back issues, surgery and recovery, packing and moving logistics while laid up. On top of all of that, Connie was working fulltime, running our home, and now caring for three (me included) children. There were many times that I wanted to throw up my hands and give up. I cannot speak for Connie, but I imagine her feeling the same way.

But our steadfast and unchanging God remained faithful. He upheld us and guided us through all the ups and downs. He led us through the dark valleys, fought our battles with the Evil One, and gave strength and healing to our weary bodies. He gave us what was necessary to accomplish what was needed to be accomplished. In the end, to God be the glory because believe me, we did not traverse this summer under our own power or ingenuity. We did not arrive here safely because we are strong. The unchanging love of God sustained us and continues to give us hope.

During the children's message at our 125th anniversary worship service I spoke about our unchanging God. I showed the kids various Bibles. The first one I showed them dated back to 1885. Next, I showed them my dad's confirmation Bible from 1964 followed by my 3rd grade Bible from 1979. I finished by showing them my preaching Bible. Our general offering year to date is \$85,278.00. We are 67% through the year and our giving so far is at 63% of our budget needs.


We are a bit behind but overall, still looking good going into the fall. We have accomplished so much and have some great plans to continue our mission with our new Pastor and his family.
